Dear Parents/Guardians:

It is time to start planning for our annual prom. Our prom will be held on **Friday**, **May 13**, **2016** from 7:30 to 11:30 at Mr. Anthony's Banquet Center. All students are expected to arrive at the dance no later than 9:00 p.m. Included in the cost of prom is a dinner that will be served at 8:00 p.m. The cost of prom will be \$40 per person or \$80 per couple. <u>Tickets will be sold from May 2 to May 6 during both lunch periods</u>. All tickets must be purchased **in advance**. Tickets will be issued only to parents/guardians of those students who are on the prom court. Because of limited space, no other adults will be permitted in the hall.

Please be aware that all students attending the prom, as with all dances, will be given a breathalyzer test. If they fail the test, you will be notified and the consequences for drinking alcohol before or at a school function will be enforced.

Some styles of prom dresses available this year are not appropriate for a Catholic High School dance. We have enclosed a copy of the dress code for the prom. We trust that students and parents will use good judgment. ALL STUDENTS WILL BE CHECKED AT THE DOOR. STUDENTS WHO DO NOT FOLLOW THE DRESS CODE WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO ATTEND PROM.

If your son or daughter is coming to the prom with a student from another school or a Mooney underclassman, they must share the dress code with their date. Students from another school must also fill out and turn in a Student Guest Form for Dances. The guest form must be signed by an administrator at the high school where the guest attends. All guests must bring a photo ID to prom. Students who are high school graduates complete the form themselves.

Seniors and juniors will be dismissed after second period at 11:20 a.m. on the day of the prom. Those attending the prom must be in school that half day. If a student has earned a free day pass, it may be used on any day.

And finally, it has also come to our attention that some students are planning not to come to school on the Monday after prom. Please be advised that this is a regular school day and students are expected to be in attendance. I ask your cooperation in ensuring that your son or daughter comes to school on that day.

We hope that your son/daughter will be able to attend prom this year. Thank you for your support and cooperation.
