Mrs. DeBartolo York and her husband, **Dr. John York**, along with her brother **Edward DeBartolo, Jr. ('64)** and his wife **Candy (Papalia) DeBartolo ('64)**, have given generously through the years to promote **Sanctity, Scholarship, and Discipline** as well as preserve our school's future. It is in small acts of kindness as well as large monetary donations, that the DeBartolo York Families have impacted our Mooney Family. It is impossible to enumerate the instances of supportive words or the generous, often unpublished contributions to students' well being that the DeBartolo York Families have contributed throughout the years. However, we have chosen to honor some of these acts below as we thank them for inspiring our Mooney Family.

It doesn't take much to figure that such a storied football family as the DeBartolo Yorks would play a crucial role in **Mooney's Annual Football Camp of Champions**. Each June, this camp draws elementary students from near and far to learn not only the fundamentals of the game, but the skills that it takes to succeed in life, such as teamwork and respect. Along with

sponsoring the overall event, Mrs. DeBartolo York has personally provided camp fees for countless students in need of assistance. Her generosity has surely impacted numerous students to positively give back to their communities. Mr. DeBartolo is a frequent contributor as well, behind the scenes and addressing the future Cards campers on the importance of respect for one's origins no matter how humble. He expanded upon this theme with his induction into the **Pro Football Hall of Fame**.

When Mr. Edward DeBartolo, Jr. was inducted into the **Pro Football Hall of Fame** in 2016 he chose to have his Hometown Hall of Famer ceremony at his alma mater Cardinal Mooney. Mr. DeBartolo chose to have his ceremony at our school to demonstrate his commitment to our community and to inspire CMHS students to follow in the philanthropic spirit of his family giving back in whichever way they can to those who helped them along their way. As part of this ceremony, CMHS was designated a Pro Football Hall of Fame High School.



Both Mrs. DeBartolo York and her brother are quick to point out that their spirit of giving back and the highest regard for education began with their parents. In their parents' honor, Mrs. DeBartolo York established the **Edward J. DeBartolo Memorial Scholarship Fund** in 1998 to assist area high school seniors pursue their secondary educations. To honor their legacy the Fund awards multiple scholarships each year to high school Seniors. These scholarships are vital in assisting Mooney students and their peers from around the Valley to attend college.

In addition to these contributions to our community, in 2014 Mrs. DeBartolo York and Mr. Edward DeBartolo provided a significant donation to CMHS that allowed for extensive renovations to our beloved school building. Their gift provided for a near complete cosmetic and structural overhaul ensuring that our students have a safe, inviting, and state of the art environment in which to pursue their studies and practice their faith. At this time, Mrs. DeBartolo York recommitted her pledge as a major donor of the school's Annual Fund Campaign. Donations such as hers provide deserving students the financial assistance to pursue their educations at Cardinal Mooney.



Inspired by the gifts and works of the DeBartolo York Families, Mooney students under Campus Minister **Susan Doyle Trewella ('69)** dedicated a **Year of Service in the DeBartolo Family's name** during the 2015-16 school year. A high light of the year included at least one hour of service given to the community by every staff member from Custodians to Teachers to Students in thanksgiving of the Families' generous gift. Each act of service was performed in conjunction with a prayer for **Mr. & Mrs. Edward DeBartolo Sr.** to honor their memories. The Pope Francis Service Award is an annual extension of the "Year of Service." Each Spring, this award is presented by the DeBartolo York Families to honor a student's commitment to service.

Recording the good deeds of Distinguished Alumni Mrs. Denise DeBartolo York and Mr. Edward DeBartolo, Jr. could fill a thousand pages as they have so clearly helped to write the story that is Cardinal Mooney High School. With these words we have attempted to proclaim the immense gratitude that we have for them as it is in their spirit and generosity that we gather our strength. Families such as theirs form the bedrock of our mission.

THE GIFT

In 2014 **Denise DeBartolo York ('68)**, her brother **Edward DeBartolo, Jr. ('64)** and their respective spouses, **Dr. John York and Mrs. Candy (Papalia) DeBartolo ('64)** made the single largest, one-time monetary contribution in the history of Cardinal Mooney High School, to be used for facility upgrades at the school. That year, to ensure the best utilization of the gift from the Families, a Cardinal Mooney **Campus Enhancement Committee** was formed. Members of the Mooney Family came together to execute a plan that sought to address safety, equity, cosmetic, and comfort issues at the fifty-year-old school on Erie Street. **Then-school President Fr. Gerald DeLucia, Chairman of the Board of Directors Dan Landers ('75), real estate and retail developer Dave Handel ('74), engineer Lou Zarlenga, and Tim Kaple** volunteered their time along with **CMHS Director of Facilities and Head Football Coach PJ Fecko ('93)** developing an ambitious plan to renovate the building.



As the project progressed, committee members gathered information from stakeholders as to the most immediate needs of the school and the most efficient methods to accomplish these. **Architect Dave Kiraly with MS Consultants** would then provide logistics for the plan's execution. Over time, other members of the Mooney Family came on board to lend their skills, such as **JD Babyak ('01) and the AP O'Horo Company** who generously provided for the school's new concrete work including sidewalks and entry ways. **Atty. Nick Cerni ('01)** lent his considerable negotiating services to assist with building permit costs.

Just in time for the beginning of the 2017-18 school year, the Committee's three-phase overhaul of the school facilities was completed. Included in the renovations were full exterior skin, lighting, and entranceway upgrades; interior asbestos abatement, new ceilings, floor, and lighting; disability compliance measures both inside and out; a new and expanded ventilation system, new roofing, and a state-of-the-art fire and safety system.

The generosity of the DeBartolo York Families and the visionaries of our Campus Enhancement Committee have provided a new home for our Cardinals. The Mooney Family offers them thanks as we promise to make the most of their incredible gifts!

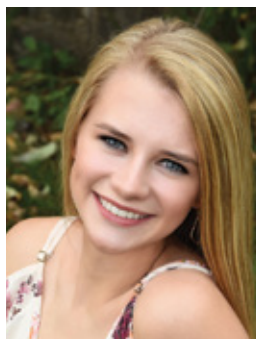

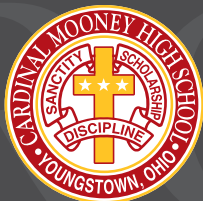
The St. Jude Fund: An Appeal for Those in Need of Hope

Four Seniors Achieve Scholastic Awards

Within the last few months, four CMHS seniors have distinguished themselves by receiving various scholastic awards. Among these awards were prominent military honors.

On February 5, Congressman Michael J. Kirwin appointed Emery Szilagyi, to the United States Military Academy at West Point. Emery, who is an honor student, was born in Hungary and can speak four other languages, French, German, Italian and Hungarian. Major-Mooney, Emery is preparing himself for the engineer's degree all West Pointers earn before they begin their active military careers.

December 10, two other seniors, Bob Slifka and Ed Crump, passed the Naval Reserve Officers Training Corps Scholarship Test and later, on February 5, passed the required physical. 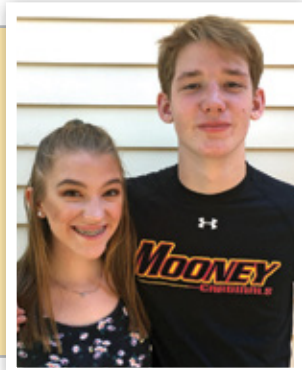

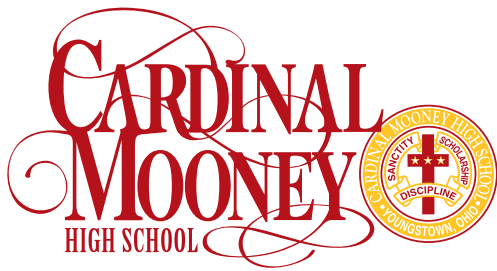
