NEW ADMINISTRATORS

NICK BEYER PRESIDENT/PRINCIPAL

Nick was named the president/principal of Cardinal Mooney High School this past spring and assumed the responsibilities on the first of July. As the new president/principal, Nick is responsible for leading the school in the areas of strategic planning, academic excellence, admissions, financial stability, spiritual leadership and external engagement.

Prior to joining Cardinal Mooney, he served as the principal of Beaumont School in Cleveland Heights, where he led in developing and implementing a long-term academic vision that included the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme authorization.

Prior to joining Beaumont School, he taught social studies and served as department chair at Benedictine High School. He is a graduate of Bowling Green State University with a Bachelor of Science in Education. He has received his Masters of Education and his Post-Masters Administration License from John Carroll University. More recently, he earned his Superintendent License through Ursuline College.

Bishop David Bonnar welcomed Nick to his position. "I am excited to announce the hiring of Mr. Nick Beyer as the new president/principal of Cardinal Mooney High School. Nick is not only a devout, practicing Catholic, but he also is passionate about Catholic education. I believe that Mr. Beyer is just what

Mooney needs at this time. He has an energy that is contagious."

JANET CADMAN ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL FOR ACADEMICS

Janet began her journey in 1999, when she taught art at St. Matthias School in Youngstown and also at St. Paul School in Salem. From there, she taught art and computers at Holy Family School. In 2012, she was hired to teach computers at Cardinal Mooney. During her time here at Cardinal Mooney, she became involved in many student activities, including Link Crew, Student Council and Ski Club. During her 22 years of teaching, she graduated from Walsh University with a Master's of Art degree, and from Youngstown State University with a Master's of Science in Educational Technology. In May of 2021, she graduated from Cleveland State University with her Principal's License.

"Education has always been a very important part of who I am," she said. "I am beyond excited to move into the role of Assistant Principal for Academic Affairs this year. I also hope that I can pass along the importance of education and getting involved in high school to our students. Being at Cardinal Mooney is a dream come true for me, and I am so very fortunate to call myself a Mooney Cardinal."



RICK SHEPAS ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL FOR STUDENT AFFAIRS

On the first of July, Rick returned home to Cardinal Mooney after graduating 40 years ago. He will assist Nick in the administrative office as principal for student affairs, where he is responsible for developing a safety and security plan for the high school, revising the student handbook and creating a vision of what a Cardinal Mooney student looks like. Mr. Shepas will also work on a plan to reconnect new students to a proud tradition at Cardinal Mooney. He brings a diverse background in education that spans more than 30 years from the elementary, high school and collegiate levels. That experience will come in handy as he assists Nick in the development of new academic programs that will create tremendous opportunities for current and future students.

Prior to returning to Cardinal Mooney, Rick was responsible for the return of the Chaney Cowboys and the East High Golden Bears within the Youngstown City Schools as the Chief of Physical Development and Athletics. He also served as head football coach and athletic

director at Waynesburg University for 12 years before leaving in 2017 as the winningest football coach in school history. He also has seven successful years as head coach and athletic director at Massillon Washington, two at Seneca Valley, and six at Poland Seminary.

Rick graduated from Youngstown State University with a Bachelor's in Sport Management. He received his Masters of Education in Sport Science from Ashland University, along with Post-Masters Administrative licensure including Superintendent Credentials. Rick is a Fourth Degree Knight of Columbus, is a member of the OHSAA and ACFA and has served on Collegiate Athletic Committees for the PAC (Presidents Athletic Conference) and NCAA Division 3 Playoff Committee.

In 1996, Rick was inducted to the YSU Athletic HOF. In 1998, he entered the Cardinal Mooney Athletic HOF and the Youngstown Curbstone Coaches HOF in 2019, as well.

He has been married to Christine for 34 years and they have three daughters, Maria 33, Kathryn 28 and Gina 25.

During All Saints Day visit to CMHS




