School Uniform

<u>Cardinal Mooney High School believes that dressing in a uniform encourages the development of self-discipline, pride in tradition, and unity among the student body.</u>

Men's Regular Uniform

Top

- The Cardinal Mooney polo shirt must be worn every day. The exception to this is on spirit top Friday.
- The Cardinal Mooney polo can be purchased at the Cardinal's Nest and come in white, black, and cardinal.
- Men may wear a Cardinal Mooney <u>non-hooded</u> sweatshirt or quarter zip over their polo. The polo still must be worn. No t-shirts or long sleeved t-shirts should be worn over the polo.
- Non-Cardinal Mooney sweatshirts and quarter zips are not allowed.
- Nothing with a full zipper may be worn at any time.

Bottom

- Khaki or Gray dress pants must be worn everyday including spirit top Fridays.
- Khaki and Gray are the only two colors allowed for dress pants.
- Between April 1st and October 31st, men may wear khaki or gray dress shorts with a 9 inch inseam.
- Khaki and gray are the only two color shorts that may be worn.
- Neither pants or shorts are allowed to have patch pockets.
- Socks must be worn at all times.
- A solid colored belt must be worn at the waist.

Women's Regular Uniform

Top

- The Cardinal Mooney polo shirt must be worn every day. The exception to this is on spirit top Friday.
- The Cardinal Mooney polo can be purchased at the Cardinal's Nest and come in white, black, and cardinal.
- Women may wear a Cardinal Mooney <u>non-hooded</u> sweatshirt or quarter zip over their polo. The polo still must be worn. No t-shirts or long sleeved t-shirts should be worn over the polo.
- Non-Cardinal Mooney sweatshirts and quarter zips are not allowed.
- Nothing with a full zipper may be worn at any time.

Bottom

- Khaki or Gray dress pants or a plaid 43 skort must be worn everyday including spirit top Fridays.
- Khaki a.nd Gray are the only two colors allowed for dress pants.
- The Plaid 43 skort is the only uniform skort allowed. The skort is a custom skort and should only be purchased at Soup City Designs. Soup City is located at 6126 Market St., Boardman, Ohio 44512. The phone number to Soup City Designs is 330-531-1333. We have had questions about a similar skort on Amazon and it is not the same skort and should not be worn.
- The Skort may not be hemmed and may be a maximum of 5 inches above their knee.

- Between April 1st and October 31st, women may wear khaki or gray shorts with a 9 inch inseam.
- Khaki and gray are the only two color shorts that may be worn.
- Neither pants or shorts are allowed to have patch pockets.
- Women may wear solid black or gray leggings or tights under their skort.
- Socks must be worn at all times without leggings or tights.
- A solid colored belt must be worn at the waist.

Sprit Top Fridays (Every Friday unless otherwise informed)

Tops: (Both men and women)

- Any Cardinal Mooney t-shirt, sweatshirt, quarter zip, team uniform, etc.
- Hooded sweatshirts are permitted on Fridays.
- The uniform polo is not required.
- Students may dress in the regular uniform if they choose.
- The top must be a Cardinal Mooney top.

Bottoms: (Both men and women)

• Both men and women are required to wear their regular uniform bottoms on Spirit Top Fridays.

Dress Down Days

Tops: (Both men and women)

- Tops must cover the shoulders and midriffs.
- Tops may not feature messaging and/or graphics that are inappropriate for school.
- Administration will have the final discretion on this matter. If a shirt is deemed inappropriate, students are subject to disciplinary action and possible removal from school for the day.

Bottoms: (Both men and women)

- Jeans, joggers, and sweatpants are allowed. Pajama pants are not permitted.
- Shorts are allowed between April 1 and October 31.
- Jeans should not have tears in them.
- Shorts must be worn at mid-thigh or lower.
- Administration will have the final discretion on this matter. If pants are deemed inappropriate, students are subject to disciplinary action and possible removal from school for the day.

Shoes

- Any solid color white, black, brown, or gray *low top* athletic shoe may be worn.
- Any solid color black, brown, or gray dress shoe may be worn.
- Athletic shoes should be as plain as possible. (Administration will have final discretion if a shoe is allowed or not).
- No colors other than those listed are allowed. Athletic shoes with a small amount of one accent color will be permitted. The accent color should be modest.
- Shoe laces must be worn, and be a solid color that matches the shoe.

Shoes that are not permitted (both men and women)

- Mid and High tops shoes of any kind
- Open toed shoes
- Shoes with an open back
- Slippers
- Sandals/Crocs
- Flip Flops
- Boots of any kind
- UGG slippers/boots/halfbacks
- Clogs
- Sling backs
- Moccasins
- Plastic or Jelly shoes
- Heels over 2 inches
- Foam shoes of any kind
- Any other shoe deemed inappropriate in a Catholic school settin

Grooming Guidelines

Men

- Body piercings of any kind are not permitted.
- Men may not disguise piercings with bandages or clear plastic studs.
- Hair should be neat and clean and must be off the collar.
- Men must be clean shaven.
- Tattoos must be covered at all times. (compression sleeves are permitted to cover them)
- Hair may only be one color and must be a color that can be naturally grown.
- Men are not permitted to wear make-up.
- No hats or head coverings of any kind.
- Administration will be the final determination on all grooming questions.

Women

- Earrings are acceptable, but should be modest.
- Nose piercings are not allowed in school at any time.
- Nose piercings may not be disguised with bandages or clear plastic studs.
- Gages are not permitted at any time.
- Make-up is allowed but must be modest and appropriate for school.
- Hair may only be one color and must be a color that can be naturally grown.
- Eyelashes must be of natural length.
- Tattoos must be covered at all times. (compression sleeves are permitted to cover them)
- No hats or head coverings of any kind.
- Administration will be the final determination on all grooming questions.
